The Centre for Equity Studies (CES) is looking for a Senior Researcher to co-manage a project on '*Strengthening rule of law to advance rights and freedoms of Manual Scavengers in India*'. The job primarily involves a comprehensive research study on the status of mandated institutions and the implementation of MSA 2013 from an equity perspective under the supervision of the Director CES. The candidate will also be expected to coordinate with funders, quarterly progress reports and oversee financial reporting related to the project. Further, (s) he will be required to work with the Director of CES on projects to study a range of concerns of public policy and equity, including inter alia manual scavenging; communal violence and hate crimes; explorations in solidarity and fraternity; jobless growth and circular migration.

**Eligibility:** Those who have completed PhD in Social Sciences or Law would be preferred. We are looking for someone with experience in field research and project management. Those with MA/M.Phil in Social Sciences or Law with publications are also welcome to apply.
